



## Character Program Idea #2

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### Character Community Wall

#### Campus Wide Activity

**Cost:** \$10

**Time:** 15 minutes for set-up

**Supplies:** Banner or Roll Paper, Tape and some markers

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- I. This is a great way to get the campus involved in CHARACTER COUNTS! week. Create a character based community wall in a commons area of your student center, library or near a food court. Anywhere on campus where there is a lot of student traffic.
- II. Ask permission or complete the appropriate forms to be able to display your wall for a week.
- III. Once approved make a large “wall” using banner paper/roll paper by cutting long strips and taping them together.
- IV. Ask a question on your “wall” or put a quote to get responses. You could ask any of the following:
  - a. How do you demonstrate character?
  - b. What does character mean to you?
  - c. To demonstrate character this week I will...
- V. Don’t forget to put Tri Sigma and #CharacterCounts or #WomenOfCharacter on your wall! You could also list the six pillars of character on the wall (Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, Citizenship).
- VI. Attach your paper “wall” to the wall or in between posts and let people respond by writing their thoughts on the wall. You could also staff a table by your wall for one day to distribute some material about the six pillars!
