Tri Sigma is seeking alumnae committed to empowering members to be and to take an active interest in their government at local, state, and federal levels.

We are seeking 4 volunteers to begin July 15th, with one volunteer leading the team.

Priority deadline to serve on the team is July 1st, 2019.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree obtained
- Knowledge of political issues impacting the future of fraternity and sorority life
- Experience in marketing lobby and leadership programs
- The leader of this team should be willing to make contributions to the Fraternity/Sorority Political Action Committee.

Expectations:

- Participate in initial training with assigned staff and/or Executive Council member to review goals and expectations of position. Time commitment: 1 hour
- Participate in regular team calls. Time commitment: 1 hour per month
- Collaborate with Education and Training to create and deliver programming encouraging active citizenship, and to educate chapters about pertinent legislative issues. Time commitment: 3-5 hours per month
- Educate and market to collegiate members to apply to lobby Congress in April each year. The chair of this team will attend the lobby event with the students selected. Time commitment: 3-5 hours per month
- Encourage members to be leaders in their schools and communities, including providing information about internships and opportunities for involvement at all levels of government.
- Create, update, and maintain database information on members who are actively involved in the political arena.
- Coordinate plans for annual congressional visits. Time commitment: 3-5 hours per month, with highest involvement from August to November
- This role is a part of a **Standing Committee**, formed to do designed work on an ongoing basis. Term ends when volunteer chooses to resign, fails to meet expectations, or if the goals of the committee are determined to no longer meet the organization's needs.
