Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree attained
- Thorough understanding of our Ritual

Expectations:

- Serve as direct resources to a region of collegiate chapters. Participate in monthly meetings with the Ritual Coordinator and Ritual Team to ensure consistent guidance is being provided to all regions. Time commitment: 1 hour per month for meetings; 3-5 hours per month as needed for additional guidance as needed
- Respond to requests from Ritual Coordinator to recommend resources, communications, programming to teach members about the Ritual and values of Sigma Sigma Sigma. Time commitment: varies, estimate up to 5 hours per month.
- Work with Department of Chapter Services to verify chapters meet accreditation verification timeline for Ritual.
- Serve as a resource person by maintaining a comprehensive understanding and appreciation for Ritual.
- Respond to requests from Ritual Coordinator to assist with annual manual review, updates to the online Ritual chair training program, and updates to Ritual book as needed.
- This role is a part of a **Standing Committee**, formed to do designed work on an ongoing basis. Term ends when volunteer chooses to resign, fails to meet expectations, or if the goals of the committee are determined to no longer meet the organization's needs.
